Message from Matt Osborne

⁶ So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. Colossians 2:6-7 (NIV)

The church in Colossians was coming up against false teachings that preached works and sacrifices to please God. These deceptive arguments sounded good but were producing a faith-based on legalism and not on Christ taking the salvation of Christ's work on the cross and making it more about our work on earth. In verse 6, Paul is urging them to come back to Christ in the way that they had first received Him by faith. Paul is emphasising our focus to be on Christ, "continue to live your lives in Him, rooted and built up in Him."

There are teachings around today that continue to put our focus on us and what we can do for salvation. Are we living in Him? Is our faith in Him only, rooted and built up in Him? When we truly strip back our lives and see the saving power of the gospel that it was all done in Him, when He said the words "it is finished," then we can live lives giving full glory to Him and overflowing with thankfulness.
