Message from Pastor Lloyd

Falling Forwards through Failure - John 21

John 21 has been used for preaching on many topics, including repentance, commissioning and empowerment, but I think it is mostly about recovery. Jesus knew that Peter needed to fail before he could become the rock upon which the church would be built. Because his failure was a pivotal turning point in his life journey of faith, it exposed him publicly and deeply.

Dan Allender has written a wonderful book entitled 'Leading with a Limp' in which he proposes that *through falling forwards when we fail, we qualify ourselves in God's service*. Failing can happen in a multitude of different ways in our lives. Put simply; failing is being 'human'.

Falling forward through failure happens:

- **When we are broken by the shame of our failure**
- **When we 're-learn' something we think we know**
- **When we experience grace as well as believe it**
- **When we rethink what God values**
- **When we walk our own pathway with its seasons**

Luke 22:31 "When you have repented and turned to me again, strengthen your brothers'...I have prayed for you that your faith might not fail."

2 Corinthians 12: 9-10 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me." He said he would glory in his weakness, so that the power of God might be demonstrated through his life... he did not mind limping *because it reminded him who he belonged to and where he came from*.

Prayer - "I have decided my life will move forward from failure, obstacles and excuses with a newly discovered knowledge of my frailty and weaknesses... and I will face the future with reckless abandonment and embrace new pathways of grace and Spirit-filled living... limping as I go."
