

Message from Pastor Matthew

THE POWER OF GOD TO OVERTHROW THE DEVIL

God's wonderful presence fill you with joy this morning, as we have a special time of worship and celebration of the sacrifice of Christ on our behalf.

My notes here are for the evening service where I will be looking at overcoming witchcraft by the power of God. Here is our main Bible reading:

They travelled through the whole island until they came to Paphos. There they met a Jewish sorcerer and false prophet named Bar-Jesus, who was an attendant of the proconsul, Sergius Paulus. The proconsul, an intelligent man, sent for Barnabas and Saul because he wanted to hear the word of God. But Elymas the sorcerer (for that is what his name means) opposed them and tried to turn the proconsul from the faith. Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked straight at Elymas and said, "You are a child of the devil and an enemy of everything that is right! You are full of all kinds of deceit and trickery. Will you never stop perverting the right ways of the Lord? Now the hand of the Lord is against you. You are going to be blind for a time, not even able to see the light of the sun."

Immediately mist and darkness came over him, and he groped about, seeking someone to lead him by the hand. When the proconsul saw what had happened, he believed, for he was amazed at the teaching about the Lord' (Acts 13:6-12).

At the end of the message I'll be leading everyone in the following proclamation prayer:

"My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, redeemed, cleansed and sanctified by the blood of Jesus. The devil has no place in me, no power over me, no unsettled claims against me, for all has been settled by the blood of Jesus at the cross. I overcome Satan by the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony.

I believe in Christ's resurrection power. Jesus is alive! He has conquered the grave, conquered death and Hell; Jesus is the winner and Satan is the loser. I renounce every kind of witchcraft and sorcery. I accept the power of God through the Holy Spirit. I believe in the power of Jesus' name and I belong to the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen."

There is power in Jesus' name and we keep speaking the release of that power here in Ranui Baptist Church. Thank you for being with us today. God bless. Pastor Matthew
