

## **Message from Pastor Matthew**

## THE SUPREME AND SOVEREIGN LORDSHIP OF JESUS

'In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
