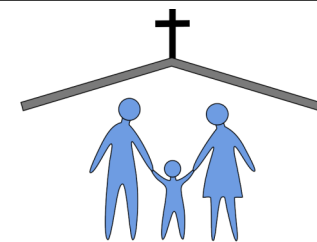

Storm

Mark 4:35-40 (NIV) Jesus Calms the Storm

³⁵ That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." ³⁶ Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. ³⁷ A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. ³⁸ Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?"



³⁹ He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm.

⁴⁰ He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

What's the worst storm you've ever been through? Let's look at the account of a severe storm on the Sea of Galilee. The crises of life are often compared to stormy seas. They come upon us whether we like it or not, and they terrify us. They knock us around and threaten to destroy all our stability and security. We don't know whether we can survive them, and we don't know how long they will last. At least, that's how a storm at sea will be for most of us. Let's look at how it was for Jesus and the boys and the lesson we can learn from this event this morning.

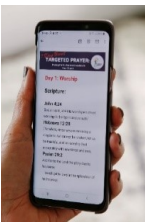
