

Message from Pastor Matthew

YOUR SPECIAL VALUE TO GOD

As we look at the wonderful subject of how important and valuable you are to God, here are the main Scriptures I will be using:

‘What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?’ (Mark 8:36-37).

‘Then God said, “Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness....” So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them’ (Genesis 1:26-27).

‘Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being’ (Genesis 2:7).

‘But for Adam no suitable helper was found. So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, he took one of the man’s ribs and then closed up the place with flesh. Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man.

The man said, “This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called ‘woman,’ for she was taken out of man.”

That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh’ (Genesis 2:20b-24).

‘So it is written: “The first man Adam became a living being”; the last Adam, a life-giving spirit. The spiritual did not come first, but the natural, and after that the spiritual. The first man was of the dust of the earth; the second man is of heaven. As was the earthly man, so are those who are of the earth; and as is the heavenly man, so also are those who are of heaven. And just as we have borne the image of the earthly man, so shall we bear the image of the heavenly man’ (1 Corinthians 15:45-49).

Never talk about yourself as being insignificant, unimportant or worthless. Stand on the fact that you are created in the image of God. Jesus is looking at you and saying, “You’re beautiful. You cost Me everything I had. I came from Heaven to die for you because You are worth it. I want you to belong to Me forever. I want you to be one of My special people.”

God bless you as you rest in God’s favour, Pastor Matthew.
