Message from Matt Hakiaha

Kingdom of God

Romans 14:17

For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost. (Life Application Study Bible - New International Version).

1. King.

Every Kingdom must have a King. Saul was the first King of Israel (1 Sam 11 and 1 Chr 10), followed by David (2 Sam 2, 1 Ki 2, 1 Chr 11 - 29), and then Solomon (1 Ki 1 and 11, 2 Chr 1 - 9). The Kingdom of Israel split into Israel in the north and Judah in the south (1 Ki 12: 26 - 33). Judah had a total of 19 Kings and 1 Queen, while Israel had 19 Kings.

Jesus as King (Rev 17:14) ...Lord of lords and King of kings. 1 Tim 6: 14 - 15 ...Lord Jesus Christ, which he will display at the proper time - he who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords.

2. In.

English word IN. In grammatical parts of speech, it is multifunctional, as a NOUN, PREPOSITION, ADVERB and ADJECTIVE. As an adjective, Beards are IN, It is what the IN crowd is wearing. Pastels and light colours are IN. As an adverb. Walked IN. Mix IN the flour and eggs. As a preposition, the Beatles were very popular IN the 60s. Banana cake in IN the container. Text written IN pencil. As a noun. Sophie has an IN with the President. They must have an IN with the manager. When you are trying to get started in the industry it helps to have an IN.

Eph 1:1 The faithful IN Christ Jesus. Eph 1:3 Blessed us...with every spiritual blessing IN Christ.

Eph 2:6 seated us with him in the heavenly realms IN Christ Jesus. Eph 3:6 ...and sharers together in the promise IN Christ Jesus. Rm 14:17...righteousness, joy and peace IN the Holy Ghost.

3. Kin. (Kinsman).

Kinship consisted basically in the possession of a common blood and was strongest nearest to its origin in the father's house, but it was not lost in the further reaches of family relationships. (page 654, 2nd edition New Bible Dictionary, IVP).

Lev 25:25 If one of your countrymen becomes poor and sells some of his property, his nearest relative is to come and redeem what his countryman has sold. (read also Lev 25: 47 - 49, -

...one of his relatives may redeem him. Ruth 2:20 That man is our close relative; our kinsman-redeemer. From Ruth you get King David and from David we get Jesus. Matt 1:6 - 16)

Jesus Christ redeems by his sacrificial blood. Heb 9:12 He did not enter by the means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.
