## **Message from Alan Telford**

### **Walk Worthy of Your Calling**

Regardless of whether we at Ranui Baptist have a Senior Pastor or not, God still expects us to do our share. It is an amazing and incredible fact that Our Father doesn't want us to depend on the presence *or absence* of a senior pastor, but rather to depend directly on Him. He also delights to entrust each one of us with our own part to play in causing the Body of Christ to grow to full maturity. In fact Revelation 19:7-8 makes it clear that Christ cannot return until we, the body, have made ourselves ready, and are living righteously. Let us encourage ourselves by remembering the plan that Jesus Christ has for each one of us.

#### *Ephesians 4:1-7, 11-16 (NKJV)*

[4:1] I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, [2] with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, [3] endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. [4] There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; [5] one Lord, one faith, one baptism; [6] one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

[7] But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.
[11] And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, [12] for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, [13] till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; [14] that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, [15] but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—[16] from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

- 1. Do you know what your calling is, and are you walking worthy of it? (verse 1)
- 2. What is the hope of your calling? (verses 2-6)
- 3. Is your calling more important than mine? Or mine than yours? (verses 2-6)
- 4. Do we each have an identical calling, or are there differences? (verses 7,11)
- 5. When will our callings no longer be required? (verse 13)
- **6.** What will be the result when we all walk in our calling? (verse 14-15)
- **7.** How do we do our share and cause the body to grow? (verse 16)
