Message from Pastor Matthew

CONFIDENCE AND SECURITY IN JESUS

'Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ' (Galatians 1:10).

'For it is not the one who commends himself who is approved, but the one whom the Lord commends' (2 Corinthians 10:18).

There are two great commandments: to love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, and to love your neighbour as you love yourself (Mark 12:28 -34). We cannot put the second commandment above the first. When we walk in obedience to the first command, the second will follow naturally. Love God first and then your love for other people will be rightly balanced. But if you put loving people ahead of loving God that is the beginning of idolatry. When we first honour God we can then love people in the way that is most beneficial.

'On the contrary, we speak as those approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel. We are not trying to please people but God, who tests our hearts' (1 Thessalonians 2:4).

The apostle Paul knew the difference between his old life without Jesus and his new life when he was found in Christ. Every person who is truly born again by the Spirit of God knows this difference. Sometimes people sit in church for a long time without being born again, but when a person no longer has confidence in their own righteousness they can then trust the righteousness of Christ and partake of His righteousness by faith.

If we seek to gain approval on any other grounds God will permit us to be frustrated because He doesn't want to meet us any other way. He wants us to appreciate the fact that being in Christ is all we need for His approval. God wants a personal relationship with us.

Jesus never worked for His Father's approval. He worked because He already had His Father's approval. That is how it should be for us. We should not be serving God to earn His favour. We should know we are approved in Christ and serve Him out of that security. Through faith in Jesus you are a child of God and you have the gift of eternal life. Our aim is to gain Christ and be found in Him. Jesus is the only source of my security. Jesus is my Lord and Saviour. This is how we must build our relationship with God.
