WHAT NATURE DID YOU RECEIVE WHEN YOU WERE BORN AGAIN?

Remember the prodigal son (Luke 15). He left his father's home, packed all his belongings, and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money on wild living. About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve. He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home, even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger! I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant."'

He wanted to be restored but he knew he wasn't the same. Something had changed. Something was broken.

Do you know the feeling you have when you put your shoes on the wrong feet, or your shirt on back to front; that feeling of something not being right? Perhaps you've been working or travelling in a foreign country and then finally you arrive back home. Suddenly everything fits. You relax. You are home. You've found where you belong.
