EPHESIANS 4 - CELEBRATE DIVERSITY AND GROW UP INTO MATURITY!

The first three chapters of Ephesians speak of what God has done to and for us, and the second three chapters are about what we do for Him! The first part is what God works into us and the second is how we work this out in our daily lives. So the book is really very practical and we now turn to live out these awesome truths day by day.

Today's message has two main points: Celebrate the Diversity we are and then Grow up into maturity in your relationship with God and each other. It constantly amazes me how God takes such huge risks with us. He trusts us to keep the faith and embrace ways of living that are counter-culture to the world's way. That he should gift us with such diverse gifts, personalities and drives is a recipe for disaster. How can this kind of diversity exist on earth without destructing? Instead of minimising differences, God seems to go overboard with making us even more diverse than telling us to live and relate together in loving harmony!!! Is it any wonder that many churches and organisations fail exactly at this point. And the only way to manage and keep the wheels on is to resort to control, rules, statements of faith, and gathering like-minded people together. Nothing could be further from the truth as far as the kingdom is concerned. A good example of this is women in ministry – we have found it easier to either ignore this or suppress it because it is just too difficult – yet how can we in the light of the teaching of scripture? The Timothy passages about women and authority and keeping silent in the church clearly has a cultural explanation and is never intended to be used in the way it has been!

Having put a bomb into the mix in the opening verses of chapter four the second half explains how unity can be maintained with this 'diverse freedom'. And the key is looking up and worshipping the same Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It is the trinity that pulls us upwards and keeps us focussed on kingdom and not our gifting or gender. The chapter closes with all kinds of illustrations of how kingdom people should live as children of the light. Here's the question for you today! Will you allow the teaching of the scriptures to shape your thinking and change your prejudice or will you relegate these matters to the 'too hard' basket of your mind?


RBC WINTER THANKSGIVING MEAL - JULY 24TH

WOMEN IN MINISTRY

For many years the issue of women in ministry has been awkward and divisive across churches and denominations. This morning I want to acknowledge, encourage, and profile some of the amazing women in ministry in our church. I will also attempt to speak about this in the message from Ephesians 4. My view is that women can hold any role, ministry, and position in church ministry and they should not be viewed as any different from men. I think the New Testament scriptures will support this. However, having said this there are some leadership roles that will be difficult to fulfill for many women – in particular, a senior pastor's role in a church staff. While such an appointment should not be precluded it might be unwise to pursue because of our sense that it doesn't easily sit well. We have women elders, women in leadership MTL positions, and women gifted in many areas of church ministry and volunteerism. All these should be celebrated and endorsed and in no way viewed as different or unusual. If it wasn't for women we would lose at least 50% of our people whom God has gifted. So this morning, I'm sensing I want to just make a statement of affirmation of the many women in our church who have faithfully served God. We thank you, love you, and stand with you to become all that God has put in your hearts to be and share with us as a congregation. Pastor Llovd
