#### **CORE VALUE No 2 - GRACE OVER PERFORMANCE**

I'm a performance kind of guy. I learned quickly that people who perform well up to expectations and beyond do well in life. They are promoted more in their careers, they seem to prosper well in friendships, and the economics and lifestyle follow close behind with a healthy bank balance. Imagine the rethinking that needed to take place when I discovered grace! That when it comes to being saved my performance doesn't register or even need to. That I cannot earn or merit my way to peace or good terms with God. This news is quite frankly disturbing because it goes against the culture that is all around me. Suddenly the goal posts that I have been familiar with for years are no longer there and I am left wondering how I can 'do well' in this new regime of kingdom thinking. Then I am faced with yet another shocker, not only is my performance not required for salvation but it's not required in day-to-day living when facing the extremes of life. I, like many others, face disappointments, obstacles, and crises of various kinds and the Bible teaches me that there is 'grace' to go through these experiences! God seems not to make them disappear but He asks me to prevail through them and come out the other side and grace somehow enables me. So grace is not just amazing when I first believe (as John Newton asserts) but even more amazing as it enables me to progress through life with faith and one day receive the 'well done' from my Lord.

What I've learned about performance is that it seems in God's ranking to be nowhere near the top, in fact, it may even be a stumbling block for many who tread the path of faith as they try and do life in the world.
