Praising God in the Valleys

I don't know about you, but I'm much better at praising God from the mountain tops than in the valley. Somehow the magnificence of the panorama looks so much better from the top than in a valley. I think the Psalmist knew this also. But somehow he had also learned that it is in the valley where costly praise is offered. It is in the valley where we truly demonstrate our allegiance and in whom we trust. When I'm on the mountain top I'm tempted to think that I got up there by my own efforts and the view from the top stimulates my endorphins. I can dream from the mountain top and aspiration and even inspiration comes in spades!
