#### CROSSING THE TWO GREAT DIVIDES - EPHESIANS 2

Ephesians chapter 2 really only has one main theme. That God has crossed the two great divides that have separated us from Him and us from each other. It's a chapter with great content about our sin condition and how helpless we are to fix ourselves. Then having crossed that great divide God sets about to reconcile people to each other. The best example of estrangement and enmity existed between the Jew and everyone else. The Jew considered themselves the special chosen people of God and in every way favoured and all others were outside of God's plan, purpose, and blessing.

Not so Paul teaches because the cross of Calvary has dealt to that! Now every people group, every nation and all have been invited to partake of Gods blessings, indeed even more than that we step right into the family and lineage which previously was only for the Jew.

What this now means is that God is creating a new community where race, colour and nationality matters not. Access to the very best blessings of God now is for all and this new community is to live out a new kingdom lifestyle free from the demands of the Jewish Law and sacrificial system.

Now the obvious application of this is that the church is now that new community where all walls and divides have been crossed and dismantled. If God can break down the separation between Jew and Gentile then He can deal to any broken relationship and estrangement.

The greatest news about all this is that you have to do nothing to receive this amazing gift of God. You are a corpse and completely dead! God comes to resurrect you to new life with him and with other people.

Why then is not the church today the best example of living out this great news? Well more about that next week!
