SERVICES IN OUR BUILDING PLAN!

You have **THREE** options available to view or attend our Church Services;

1. **AUDITORIUM SERVICE** - you should come into the church auditorium using the rear car park, please show your vaccine pass at the door and scan or sign in (100 person limit).
2. **CAFE SERVICE** - If you wish to attend the Open Service you can come into the café but please use the front roadside car park entrance (you will still need to enter the car park off Greenock Road and drive around), no vaccine pass is required, please scan or sign in at the door (25 person limit).
3. **YOUTUBE ONLINE LIVE** - You may also see the service online through YouTube which will be screened live (However, we want you to come to the building if possible).

- We encourage people to wear masks during the service (except for those on stage who are exempt from this).
- Toilet facilities will be clearly marked for your use. (There will be separate facilities for each group).
- Both groups will not be able to meet together in the building.
- There will be no after-service refreshments.
- Please wash your hands and practice social distancing (you may sit together in your bubble).
- Please be patient and adaptable – this is not easy for anyone – but we all want to meet in our buildings at last!

NOTE: The Café will receive a direct video from the church auditorium with both picture and sound. We will review the plans weekly as necessary.
