### TRUST IN THE LORD WITH ALL YOUR HEART AND LEAN NOT TO YOUR OWN UNDERSTANDING - PROVERBS 3:5-6

Today I'm starting a final series of messages for the year entitled 'Timeless' - It's ten messages taken from various parts of the Bible which are favourites. In today's message, I want to explore why God asks us to trust Him even when our understanding and perspective tell us not to. Maybe we have been confronted with some event or misfortune that it might appear God has deserted us or turned His back on our pleas for help. Yet he still asks us to trust him! It seems even cruel to ask, but why could this be? God sits on His hands and seemingly does nothing as we face the valley of darkness. What good could possibly come out of this kind of experience? Anyway, doesn't following God in some measure guarantee that we will have straight paths? Does our insight into what a straight path need to be re-thought? I hope this message will encourage those of you facing challenges at the moment to keep trusting. I don't know about you but I'm always going to defer to my own understanding of what's going on in my life. But just maybe God has a different 'larger story' He is wanting to tell through my pathway that I might not have chosen.
