GRACE AND MERCY, THE CULTURE OF THE KINGDOM:

Does it disappoint you how sometimes people who say they love Jesus also love to speak and act in ungraceful ways? Why is the Church today across our country so divided even though we worship the same Jesus? We have got ourselves into our own 'church bubbles' where others are welcome as long as they believe the same things. Then there is the way we treat people who fail and lose their way especially if they are believers, we often find ourselves distancing ourselves from them. Read again the gospels and the way Jesus relates to people who fail and mess up, He is truly remarkable in the way He supports the person but somehow doesn't condone the sin. But underlying all his speech and interaction with people are – mercy and grace. In fact, this coming King which is 'upside down' to the world's way of doing things is characterised by mercy and grace.

So next time when a situation confronts you – ask yourself if you responded with grace and mercy instead of judgment and indifference. I know it's difficult but it's the only way the Church here can take on the 'upside down' Kingdom and we can be seen to be a very different way to the rest of the world. We need more of the kingdom in the Church.

Todays verse I want to share with you is from Ephesians 3:2,4,8,10 But God who is so rich in **mercy**...

It is only by God's grace you have been saved....

God saved you by his grace when you believed....

He has created us anew in Christ Jesus so we can **do the good works** he planned for us long ago.
