The Choice that Keeps Choosing Galatians 2:20

Something about choice doesn't always sit right with me. I love the idea of choice and that I have this freedom to choose because you see I would be the first to complain if I had no say in my life choices. But then once the matter is settled that I do have a choice, then I feel the pressure of having to make the right choice. Why is it, that I cannot just settle the matter with one 'big' choice? Does God want to be impressed with me keeping choosing Him? Then I saw something in this reoccurring groundhog day experience (If you don't know what groundhog day is you need to see the movie). This 'keeping on choosing' is what the Bible means when Jesus spoke of taking up the cross daily and following Him. It's not about making a 'big choice' once and for all, it's about making a daily choice to keep choosing Him and not me! The need to do this is not for God's benefit but for mine! It is me that needs to be reminded of who I am following and why. This last week I spoke with my 15-year-old granddaughter about baptism. She had resisted being baptised for some years but asked me some weeks ago if I would baptise her on Boxing Day when all our families are together. We spoke about the meaning of baptism and 'choosing' to follow Jesus and then living out that choice day by day. What a thrill to share this truth with her. When Paul wrote to the Galatian believers in this letter he was trying to explain this same principle. "It is no longer I who live but Christ who lives in me" – and I keep choosing Him daily and in doing so am a walking example of dying to my old life and living the new life in the power of the Spirit. Will you say with me – Jesus today I keep choosing you over all else! It's not a choice that leads to stuffy, boring, rules-based faith but an exciting, liberating, and abundant life.

CHRISTMAS LUNCH TICKETS - NEXT SUNDAY 18th DECEMBER:


