

Here is the final message in the ten Timeless verses series. Philippians 1:6 The book was written from prison by Paul to the church at Philippi. From a place of restriction and withdrawal, but Paul knew that prison walls were no barrier to the kingdom. He did his best work in restricted circumstances! 
