2 Corinthians 13:5 says "Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Or do you not realise this is about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you? Unless indeed you fail to meet the test"

There are many times in life when we go through running tests for our health or maybe educational exams. In most of these cases, the process can be uncomfortable and we may fear a bad result. However, we proceed with the tests in life as we know evaluation is important to know areas we need to fix and to affirm and qualify us in areas where we are doing well.

In the Bible it asks us several times to examine ourselves to see if we are in the faith, Paul doesn't want us to just assume that things are going well but to run an examination of our faith, and the Bible tells us how to do this. This may be an uncomfortable process but it is done to keep us from being "ineffective and unproductive in our faith" and so it's important to do. But we don't need to do it through fear if we are in Christ, for he will keep us firm.

"To him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy, to the only God our saviour be the glory, Majesty, power, and authority through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages for now and forevermore, amen".
