

The Unstoppable Gospel. Paul is both thankful and excited to receive news of the church at Philippi which he has enjoyed a close and loving relationship with. He also introduces a main theme of his letter Joy. He will go on to use this word 14 times in this letter more than any other letter he writes.

Paul wants them to know that despite his imprisonment the news of the Gospel has spread. He is not worried about those who oppose him or his status with the secular authorities. The question of whether he lives or dies is moulded by his commitment to the advancement of the gospel. The Gospel is like a mighty river flowing down a river. Nothing can stand in its way and this fills him with Joy. Paul is encouraging the Philippians in the face of a hostile community and real persecution to stand firm in their faith and not to be scared by the opposition. They are called to be united by the spirit in belief and in their suffering.
