Grahame Walker

When we turn from chapter two of Philippians to chapter three the letter takes a dark turn. In chapter two we hear Paul's repeated encouragement to celebrate life, God and one another. To look to the good and faithful examples of Epaphroditus and Timothy. Finally, to acknowledge the example of Jesus as the ultimate example of humili-

Its not too long into chapter three that Paul transitions from celebration into warnings of danger and evil that could lead the young church into trouble. The whole chapter is an example of Christian theology gone wrong. Dependence on the flesh rather than on Christ and rejection of the cross rather than embracing a way of life that follows the crucified Jesus.

There were those in Paul's churches who claimed spiritual perfection or elite transcendence. He is quick to remind the church that all believers are on a journey to grown in faith, righteousness and holiness. So, anyone who pretends to be spiritually faultless is fooling themselves. He ends this chapter by reinforcing that Christian hope is not wishful thinking. It is longing for complete transformation and the restoration of all things in Jesus Christ.
