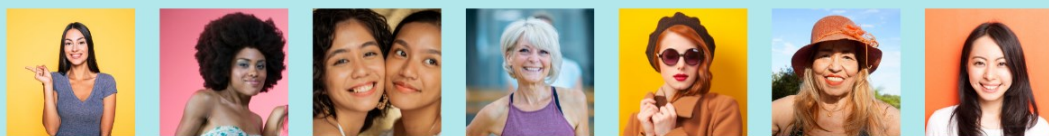

LUKE 17

In Luke 17: 11-19, Jesus is going into a village when ten men who have leprosy call out to him. Jesus was merciful and healed all ten. However, only one returned to give thanks to Jesus, praising God as he did. Jesus had his disciples with him and there was probably a bit of a crowd of onlookers watching the proceedings. So, Jesus uses this as a teaching moment and asks, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?"

Healing must have brought incredible change in these men. They were healed of all signs of leprosy. They could now show themselves to the priest and be cleared to enter fully back into community life. Yet, only one returned to Jesus. This reminds us that Jesus ministers to any who reaches out to him. None are turned away. He often ministered to those who were outsiders, especially those whom others had given up on. Perhaps also the reaction of the nine in not returning to Jesus acts as a warning not to take God's gracious actions for granted.
