#### **INSPIRE #5—HABAKKUK**

The prophets usually bring God's word to the people. Habakkuk brings the people's word to God. The prophet lives in very difficult times and becomes frustrated at what he perceives as God's lack of intervention. Violence and injustice are rampant and God's law is being ignored. So, he cries out for God to do something. When God answers, Habakkuk is in shock. God will use Babylon to invade Iudah and destroy Ierusalem.

Habakkuk goes back to God asking how can he use these people to bring Justice. God lets the prophet know that judgment will come to Babylon. Habakkuk is reminded of the mighty power of God to bring Justice. His heart has turned from frustration with God to worship and awe. He started wrestling with God but now has embraced God. Although he knows calamity is coming, he will rejoice in God his saviour.
