Grahame Walker

Philippians 4:

In the last chapter of Philippians Paul addresses a particular disagreement in the church between two women leaders. They clearly had some standing in the church and with the Apostle. Paul does not take sides but reminds them of the work they did together for the sake of the Gospel. Again, even though he is in prison and facing an uncertain future, the Joy of the Lord springs from him.

The church was troubled and anxious because they were being abused (verbally and socially, probably not physically) by their unbelieving neighbours. He reminds them that the Lord is close to them and that the God of peace will be with them. This opens up a broader discussion about dealing with worries and finding Christian joy and focusing on what is praiseworthy and beautiful.

Paul finishes this chapter as he began, thanking the church for sharing in his troubles. He talks about God teaching him the secret of contentment. This does not remove hardship but God takes care of his people no matter what life throws at them. This leads Paul to praise the ever-present God who gives, loves, and rewards his people.


