LET'S GET OUR GOSPEL RIGHT (1 CORINTHIANS 15:1-4)

Many people today including some professing Christians, unfortunately don't know what the true gospel is. So I thought to start 2024 off with a reminder about getting our gospel right! According to the word of God!

The word gospel means "good news" in the original language of the Bible. When Christians talk about the gospel, they are presenting the good news of how Christ's death and resurrection reconcile sinners to God. The aim of our message today is to provide a full context of the gospel: how a holy God created the world, how the world fell into sin and brokenness, how God offers salvation to people, and how everyone who repents and believes in the gospel can be saved.

The core of the gospel message can be summarized in our text from 1 Corinthians 15:1-4. Paul stated, . . . "Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures."
