

THE GOSPEL OF JOHN - 'I AM' STATEMENTS

John's Gospel records Jesus describing himself with what is commonly known as his "I AM" statements. Here they are; I am the bread of life, I am the light of the world, I am the door, I am the good shepherd, I am the resurrection and the life, I am the way, the truth and the life and I am the true vine. That phrase "I AM" is considered very bold by Jesus. Jesus is drawing his listeners back to *Exodus 9:70; God said to Moses, "I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.'*

This is the most Holy word in existence because it is the very name of God. It was considered so Holy that the Jews would not even write it out completely. They would only write the consonants: Y H W H. The closest we can make out in light of the missing vowels is that it was pronounced "Yahweh." God said my name is "Yahweh", "I AM." This is what Jesus said about his identity, "I tell you the truth", Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!" John 8:58
