

GETTING BACK ON TRACK SUMMARY:

We have just completed a series on first and second Kings. These books are rich in witness to God wanting to help his people get back on spiritual track. Over five Sundays we looked at five things that God wanted to get across to the people of Israel that would put them back on track with him as their God. For us, these five areas can apply to our own lives to ensure we stay on spiritual track with God.

We read how king after king went astray from God. They failed to have their heart turned towards him, they worshiped other gods and idols, they did not take down the high places and let these strongholds take over their lives. Further, they stopped listening and responding to God even after he gave them clear instructions about the future.

Only one king turned to God and obeyed the Torah. He pulled down the false gods, idols and strongholds. He listened to God and God responded. ²⁵Neither before nor after Josiah was there a king like him who turned to the LORD as he did—with all his heart and with all his soul and with all his strength, in accordance with all the Law of Moses. 2 Kings 23: 25.
