#### This Week's Sermon: The Life of Gideon

This morning, we will look at another Judge called Gideon. The first five books of the Bible end with the death of Moses, and the people of Israel getting ready to enter the promised land. Then we read about Joshua, the successor of Moses, leading the people of Israel into that land and taking possession. Joshua eventually dies, and as the people begin to settle, they appoint leaders known as Judges. Sadly, the books final verse sums up what happened. In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as they saw fit. Judges 21:25.

Gideon was weak physically and spiritually. Yet, he was who God picked, and who God used. Despite all Gideon's issues, God used him in a mighty way. In fact, with an army of only three hundred men, Gideon defeated the Midianites. He then became the first Judge of Israel, even being known as the warrior judge, known for strength and bravery and faith in God. Obviously, his whole life was a Godthing.

God took Gideon who lacked faith and needed constant reassurance that he could do what God asked of him. Here is what God tried to instill into him. When the angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon, he said, "The Lord is with you, mighty warrior." Judges 6:12.

The Lord turned to him and said, "Go in the strength you have and save Israel out of Midian's hand. Am I not sending you?" Judges 6:14.

The Lord answered, "I will be with you, and you will strike down all the Midianites, leaving none alive." Judges 6: 16.

Now all the Midianites, Amalekites and other eastern peoples joined forces and crossed over the Jordan and camped in the Valley of Jezreel. Then the Spirit of the Lord came on Gideon, and he blew a trumpet, summoning the Abiezrites to follow him. Judges 6:33-34.

Catch the theme? You can do what I have asked you to do. You have strength. You can do great things. That's what God sees in you. That's who he made you to be. That's first. Then God adds, "And I am with you. Whatever weakness you have will be compensated for with my strength." I want to say this morning that both are true for us this morning.
