This Week's Sermon - Grahame:

What's the Difference? Mormon & Jehovah Witnesses

We are in a series on the difference between Christianity and world religions. Today, we're going to look at two founded in America. They are the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, better known as Mormons, and the Watchtower Society, better known as Jehovah's Witnesses.


