This Week's Sermon - Grahame:

Praying for the Prodigals (Prayer Month)

This morning, I want to introduce our prayer month. The main theme of this year's prayer month is praying for the prodigals. Many of us know people who used to be part of a Church but for various reasons have drifted away. Some of us may even have family members who are in this category. Our prayer is that we want them to come back. Come back to a vibrant relationship with Jesus and a committed return to the church.
