This Week: Sermon on the Mount #4

In Matthew 5: 21-22, there are two main principles. The first principle Jesus gives is simple, but super hard. When there is relational conflict, don't give in to hate. Don't let it escalate into hate, anger and bitterness. Don't fight back or attack. The second principle that Jesus is wanting to communicate is that we must pursue reconciliation, even if it takes years.

Jesus does not mince his words. I like how Dietrich Bonhoeffer in his book on Discipleship puts it, **Anyone who is angry toward a brother or sister, who aims harsh words at them, who scorns or slanders another in public, has, as a murderer no place before God. Alienating oneself from another person causes alienation from God. As long as we withhold service and love from our brothers and sisters, as long as he or she remains a target of our contempt, as long as a sister or brother has something against me or Jesus' community our worship and offering will remain unaccepted by God.**
