This Week: Sermon on the Mount #13 (Matthew 7:7-12)

So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets. Matthew 7:12. What does this mean in practice? The Bible casts a vision for it through what have been called the “one another’s.” They’re called that because throughout the Bible and particularly the New Testament there are verses that use that phrase, “one another”, as it lays out how we should flesh out the golden rule.

- “Live in harmony with one another.” Romans 12:16.
- “Be patient, bearing with one another in love.” Ephesians 4:2.
- “Spur one another on toward love and good deeds.” Hebrews 10:24.
- “Accept one another.” Romans 15:7.
- “Stop passing judgment on one another.” Romans 14:13.
- “Be kind and compassionate to one another.” Ephesians 4:32.
- “Strengthen one another.” Romans 14:19.
- “Forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another.” Colossians 3:13.
- “Offer hospitality to one another.” I Peter 4:9.

And then, repeatedly, is this, first uttered by Jesus himself: “Love one another.” John 13:34.
